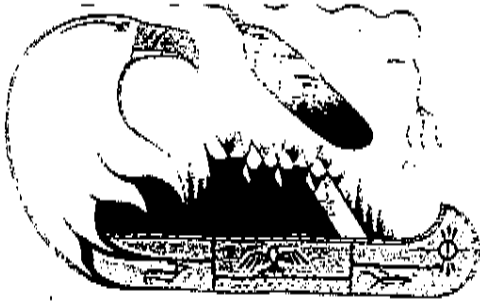

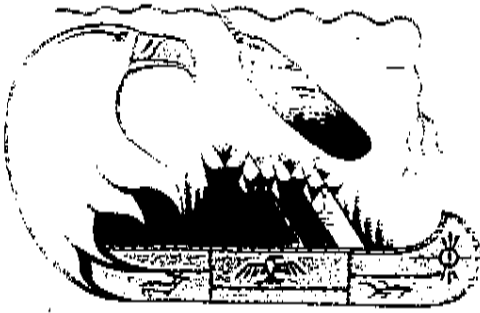

Dear Community Members,

Kiikenomaga Kikenjigewen Employment and Training Services (KKETS) have developed a new training initiative, **Aboriginal Skills Advancement Pilot Program**. The ASAPP is a one of a kind training program designed for individuals living in Matawa First Nation communities and specifically aimed at adult learners aged 22 and up.

The objectives of ASAPP are to provide 100 learners from Matawa First Nation Communities with access to the skills and academic upgrading required to meet current industry standards and employment opportunities in the Ring of Fire. This three-tiered program combines academic upgrading, real-world skills, and training programs; each individualized level brings you closer to employment success.

The ASAPP will take place in Thunder Bay and will require successful applicants to relocate for program duration; training and living allowance will be available for eligible applicants.

The Aboriginal Skills Advancement Pilot Program provides access to:

- Literacy/upgrading
- Basic Certification/tickets
- Increased Aboriginal participation in the Trades
- Upgrading/literacy/GED/ACE/Grade 12 equivalency
- Career and employment path Development
- Connections to employment
